

4 Weeks before Moving Day

- Check with your insurance company to confirm your possessions are covered during transit.
- Schedule connection of utility services at your new home and disconnection at your old home including electricity, water, sewage, cable, Internet, telephone, and trash disposal service.
- **File a change of address** with the US Postal Service and pick up a Mover's Guide at your local Post Office.
- **Purchase locks for your new home** or arrange to have them installed.
- Arrange for cleaning and repair of furniture, carpets, drapes, etc.
- Sort and sell items you no longer love. A garage sale can lighten your moving load and give you extra funds for your move.
- O Make any necessary travel plans for your move.
- Gather personal and family records, including medical and dental, school records, legal and financial documents, birth certificates, passports, and insurance documents.
- Arrange for furniture shipping, POD transfers, and moving vans.

## 2 Weeks before Moving Day

- O **Return any borrowed items,** such as library books, and retrieve what you have loaned.
- **Prepare auto registrations for transfer** if you are moving to another state.
- Order new checks so they will be ready by moving day.

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• Arrange for pet transportation. Will you be flying? Will you need space in your car for a crate? What supplies will you need on hand if you are driving?



## 1 Week before Moving Day

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- O Send change-of-address cards to everyone who will need to contact you.
- Assemble a travel backpack with the following: checkbook, credit cards, phone records, identification, keys, flashlight, mobile phone charger, camera, toiletries, towels, travel alarm clock, first aid kit, bottled water, paper plates and cups, and entertainment.
- Pack your suitcases with clothing and personal items.
- Clean and sort your pantry and household items. Donate what you can to local shelters and food kitchens.
- Make child care arrangements for moving day.
- **Update subscriptions and prescriptions.** Transfer newspaper, magazine, and mailing subscriptions to your new address and transfer medication prescriptions to a pharmacy in your new neighborhood.

The Day before Moving Day \_\_\_\_\_

- O **Transfer your bank accounts** if necessary.
- Have an adequate amount of cash on hand for any travel expenses you cannot pay for with credit.
- Empty, defrost, and clean your refrigerator and freezer at least 24 hours before moving day. Use empty space to store household items if appliances will be coming with you to the new house.
- O **Disconnect and prepare major appliances** if you are taking them with you.
- Pack a box of items that you will need right away at your new home and label it "Load Last."
- Check every room one last time before confirming that everything is loaded.
- Pet check. If travelling with you, make sure you have an adequate supply of food, any medications, leashes, a water dish, and travel crate packed.



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
